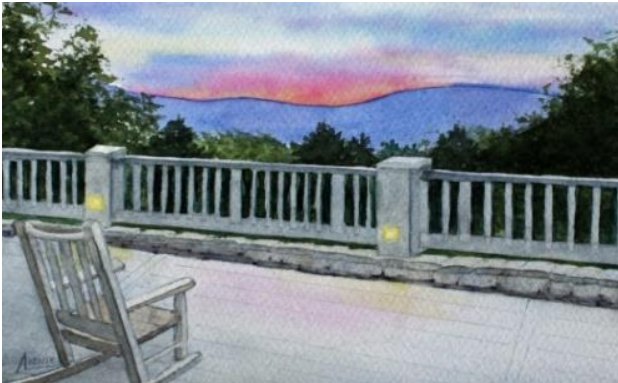
Sketchbook Watercolor Journaling

Sketchbook journaling is a relaxing and meditative way for us to slow down and savor the "ordinary things" we take for granted: a special object, place visited, favorite quote, beautiful flower, etc. You will be creating a beautiful keepsake from moments of your life.

In this we will be talking about sketching tips, designing the layouts of our pages, using borders, format boxes and how to create faux calligraphy. During class you will design and sketch your own sketchbook pages using the concepts taught.



Instructor will provide: A watercolor journal, a special sketching pencil, angle finder, view finder and a large handout with examples of her personal journal pages, page layouts designs, borders, faux calligraphy techniques, inspirational quotes and more.

Students should bring: Pencil, Sakura Micron pen (black, size 01), art eraser, ruler, watercolor paints and palette, watercolor brushes, water containers and paper towels.
