- Background fabrics such as Osnaburg, Linen or Organza (approximately 7" x 8" for each page)
- Small assortment of coordinating printed fabrics (Susan used Tula Pink's fabric line)
- Quilter's Dream Fusion Request Batting (craft size)
- Embroidery threads such as pearl cotton (all weights) crewel thread, metallic threads, silk ribbons
- Scissors and pins
- #22 Chenille needles, #1 Milliner needles
- Fabric marking pencil (chalk or silver artist pencil)

* There will be threads and fabrics available for purchase during classes.
