Artful Crazy Quilt Necklace

Join Susan for some fun stitching and beading in this **Crazy Quilt Piecing** class. It's a very unique and artistic way of piecing.

This necklace is very simple to piece either by hand or on the sewing machine. The embroidery, beading and embellishments add so much personality to the piece!

You will learn hand embroidery and various beading techniques incorporated into Crazy Quilt Piecing.

The first session will focus on piecing, embroidery and beading. Session 2 will focus on constructing the

necklace and setting eyelets for the chain or ribbons. A sewing machine is needed for Session 2.

Supply List

- Crazy Quilt Necklace Pattern (\$10.)
- Muslin (Fat Quarter 18" x 22")
- 5-7 small pieces of fabric (cottons and/or silks) prints and solids that work together. *No heavy upholstery fabrics.*
- Ribbon or chain for the necklace part and 22 gauge wire with jewelry tools (Susan will have some to share in class if you don't have any)
- Beads, charms, etc. for embellishments (seed beads and small "pea" size beads for drops, or any beads that can be used for drop/dangles.)
- Fine Applique Needle, Short Beading needle or Straw Needle for beading
- Pearl Cotton Embroidery threads to contrast with the fabrics (Many types of pearl cotton embroidery threads will be available for purchase during class)
- #22 Chenille Needle, #1 Milliner Needle (#1 Milliner needles will be available for purchase during class)
- **Sewing machine**, or needle and thread for hand piecing. Sewing machine is needed for session 2 for the necklace construction.



*Susan will have eyelets and the setting tool needed for the chain, if you are using chain.
