We'll be using Stumpwork 3-D embroidery stitches as well as various other interesting and unusual stitches.

The textural elements will inspire you to make more pieces for a fabric book, a little garland, or perhaps even a wall quilt.

Supply List

- Pattern: \$10.
- Scissors
- Backing Fabric (10" square or so)
- Pins (flat head flower pins)
- Fabric chalk or silver pencil
- Light (small for doing handwork)
- Pearl cotton #5 and #8 in colors: Petals (pink or orange), greens, browns, gold, orange
- #22 chenille needle
- Small mother of pearl buttons (optional)

Includes: Pattern (\$10.), background fabric (Hand dyed Osnaburg), fusible batting, hand dyed cheesecloth, hand dyed silk rayon velvet, vintage rayon ribbons, #22 chenille needle
