This class is designed for people with any level of experience, beginners to advanced, who would like to have fun with art. You will make a whimsical standing bird with lots of personality. The instructor will provide basic stained glass supplies. The cost of these materials has been worked into the cost of the class. Participants are asked to bring a few supplies that are common to most households. A supply list will be provided at registration.

Maximum: 5 participants, so sign up early to reserve your seat

Level: Beginners to Advanced, no experience is required

The class will likely only take 3 hours but we are reserving 4 hours in case we need it. We will take a short lunch break if needed.

In this class, you will learn to use simple stained glass techniques; cutting, grinding, foiling, and soldering. Susan will discuss safety and the use of tools. She will demonstrate and then help you individually.

Susan Lackey has been painting in watercolors and mixed media for many years. She also creates artwork in stained glass, focusing mostly on three-dimensional pieces. She has won numerous awards in area shows. She is a signature member of the Watercolor Society of North Carolina. Susan currently teaches in Concord and privately.



Stained Glass Birds: Supply List

Participants will bring the following materials:

- An old toothbrush
- Needle nose pliers
- Plastic or nitrile gloves, the flux we use is soldering is a mild acid and may dry out your hands
- Small plastic wash pan or dish pan
- Paper towels
- An old cloth hand towel or dish towel
- Pencil with an eraser
- Sharpie or other black marker
- Sketch book or white paper for sketching and notes
- Scissors
- Band-Aids
- Plastic safety glasses. If you wear glasses, bring the kind that will fit over your glasses. You need these for grinding

- Tools provided by Cabarrus Art Guild include; grinders, soldering irons, and hand tools used in stained glass artwork
- Instructor provided materials include;
 - Stained glass in various colors
 - Solder
 - Copper foil
 - Tinned copper wire
 - Chemicals: flux and patina
