## **Batik Painting**

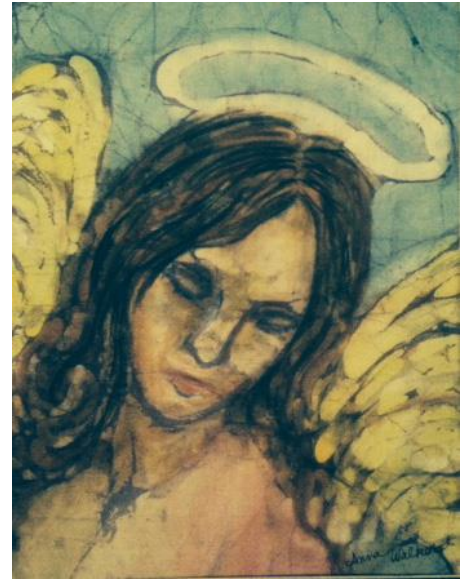

Batik is an ancient art technique that usually requires many applications of wax and dye but in this class we will do a very simple method using wax, crayon and dye to achieve amazing results. No experience is required and the workshop is open to anyone 14 and older.

In this class the student will design and create a 14"x18" batik using fabric stretched on a wood frame. The color will be applied with melted down wax and crayon using a brush. Once all color has been painted on the fabric it goes into the dye bath. After that the fabric is ironed between paper to remove the wax for a spectacular effect. The results are amazing and no prior painting experience is necessary.



All materials and supplies are provided by instructor. Bring an apron or old shirt to protect your clothes. Participants may bring a bag lunch if they choose.
