Bailey has participated in many student art exhibits including the Impulse exhibit held annually at Clearwater Artist Studios and Gallery in Concord and the Juried Autumn Show held at Rail Walk Studios and Gallery in Salisbury. Additionally, her works can be found in various businesses from Winston-Salem to Charlotte.

Bailey believes in using art to connect with her local community. She helped to plan and organize the Kaleidoscope Cultural Arts Festival in Downtown Kannapolis from 2014-2016. In 2015 she was selected to be the Featured Visual Artist at Salisbury's Annual Chickweed Festival and she has curated and hung artworks for several showcases at the Salisbury Business Center. In 2016 she organized a charity event called Healing Hearts through Healing Art, through which she was able to supply more than 15 original artworks from artists spanning 5 North Carolina counties. Those artworks were used to decorate the Holly Haven Family Care Residence in Winston-Salem, which provides care to people battling advanced stages of HIV.
