Types of artwork accepted are listed in the  
Accepted Artwork section below.

The Exhibit Committee may choose not to  
show any artwork they feel is inappropriate  
or does not follow exhibit guidelines.

### Submission email must include

- **Artist name** (as you want it to show on the  
website)
- **Title**
- **Price** (if for sale) or **NFS**
- **Medium**
- **Height and Width** (of artwork only)

If possible, send a separate email for each entry  
so we can match the description with each  
photograph.

### Eligibility:

Guild members and non-members residing in  
Cabarrus and surrounding counties are eligible  
to enter. All artists must be at least 18 years of  
age.

Artwork created or begun in a classroom setting,  
with a mentor, or copied from another piece of  
art is not eligible for judged shows. All artwork  
must be original and created by the exhibiting  
artist.

All entries must have been completed after October 1, 2018, and not shown previously in any Cabarrus Art Guild judged show.

Your submission implies that you meet all requirements of eligibility.

#### **NC Sales Tax:**

For art sales during the show, the Cabarrus Art Guild will not collect sales tax. Artists must handle their own sales tax reporting and payment as required by NC law.

## **ACCEPTED ARTWORK:**

**Submissions are accepted only for the following types of artwork. All entries must be of original design, i.e. not created with the help of an established pattern, form or mold.**

**Painting:** Artwork made with oils, acrylics, pastels, alcohol ink or watercolors.

**Drawing:** Artwork created with pen, pencil, charcoal, chalk, or other marking tools.

**Mixed Media:** Two-dimensional artwork incorporating more than one material or medium.

**Printmaking:** Prints made by woodcuts, silk-screening, etching and intaglio, and mono prints.

**Sculpture:** Three-dimensional artwork of any material.

**Unaltered Photography:** Photography with no changes in raw format.

**Modified Photography:** Any digitally modified photographic image.

**Digital Artwork:** Any digitally manipulated source material that is computer generated.

**Basketry:** Functional or sculptural artwork using woven or plaited materials. May be 2D or 3D.

**Clay:** Functional or sculptural artwork using made predominately of clay. May be 2D or 3D.

**Fiber:** Artwork in which the primary material is fiber including soft sculpture, batik, quilting or painted fabric from original designs only. May be 2D or 3D

**Glass:** Artwork in which the primary material is glass form original designs only. No manufactured molds or other forms of mass production. May be 2D or 3D.

**Prints and Giclee's are not allowed in judged shows.**
